The average in the region is 1,225 EUR, while nationwide it is 1,147 EUR.


Wages in Brno have risen sharply in recent years. Last year alone the average wage soared by 106 EUR.

WOMEN TAKE ONE QUARTER LESS MONEY, Specifically 363 EURless.


The salary gap between men and women is not closing. The average salary of a man is 1,426 EUR while that of a woman is 1,063 EUR.


RETAIL SHOPS'

ARE COMING TO YOU.

The City of Brno once again appeared among the best in the evaluation made by the prestigious British economic magazine fDi, published by The Financial Times.

In the category of Human Capital and Lifestyle, Brno ranked sixth among medium-sized European cities.

AN OPINION POLL THAT WILL PLEASE YOU.

96.8% of you are satisfied with Brno as the place where you live.

In 2009, it was 90.2%, then 91.9% in 2013.

SAFETY.

WE ARE QUITE CALM.

Nearly four out of five Brnoers feel safe in their city. This is a remarkable increase compared to the 2009 survey, when the figure was around 55%.

According to current research, the Czech Republic is considered the sixth safest country in the world.

THE CRIME RATE IS DECREASING.

Compared to 2008, the number of criminal acts perpetrated in Brno decreased by more than one third. 10,391 crimes were committed in 2017. Of course, this number is not really low, but the trend is good.

The number of apartments offered for short-term lease through Airbnb is growing exponentially. It was 1 in 2010, 246 in 2015 and 1,066 in 2017. What does this mean?

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE THEM TO COME AND HELP YOU?

The time flies down.
The target for 2050
is 5 minutes.

The average arrival time of firefighters gets shorter every year. The target for 2050 is 5 minutes! In 2013 the arrival time was 7 minutes and 45 seconds; in 2016 we managed to cut it down by another minute.

The medical rescue service in Brno went on 46,920 callouts. It managed to stay within the legal limit of 20 minutes in 98.43% of cases.

Between the years 2015 and 2016, the number of physicians in Brno grew by 82. Having accessible healthcare simply is important.

The number of doctors is growing in the whole country as well. While in the were 38,818 of them in 2009, there were 38,818 of them in 2016 they were 49,102.

In Brno, there are almost 112 beds per 10,000 inhabitants, while the nationwide average is less than 54 beds.



Of course, this is because Brno's hospitals serve a much larger region than just the city itself.

WHAT DO ERASMUS STUDENTS

We asked students who are in Brno on the ERASMUS programme how they enjoyed their stay here and what specifically they liked. Their answers made us happy – 98% of them are satisfied.

Obviously, clubs, pubs and good beer remain our key assets. But people also valued highly the city's excellent public transport system, its parks and the historic city centre.

Dissatisfaction? It hardly exists.



CULTURE.

THE CITY IS PROUD OF IT.

Brno spends more on culture than comparable cities. Only Pilsen, the European City of Culture in 2015, leaves us behind.

Just for the sake of comparison – Olomouc supports culture with 2.08% of its budget, Ostrava 1.98% and Prague 1.49%.

Greenery in the centre is one of the city's priorities.



Every year Brno spends more than half a billion crowns on environmental protection.

The amount has not changed significantly over the years. It remained more or less the same in the so-called crisis years.

Conversely, perhaps a bit surprisingly, the lowest precipitation is in the month of October (25mm).

The warmest ground surface in the city during the summer, and at the same time the coldest during the winter, is at the Brno Exhibition Centre.

Yes, even the Majáles student festival festival sometimes is a real storm.





YOU ARE STILL IN

A HIGHER CLASS FOR SORTING.

"Thank You for Sorting" – it really does apply in Brno. By the way, every year we have more and more containers for sorted waste.

1,463 containers for paper, 1,434 for plastics, 911 for glass and 126 for textiles are available to Brnoers.

Do you know that through Brno iD you can make a payment for waste for the whole family simply online?

THE CITY BUDGET IS BREAKING RECORDS

This year, the city plans to receive an income of EUR 463 million and to spend a record-breaking EUR 573 million. It wants to make investments into major transport infrastructure.

The first year of the participatory budget can boast of some really good figures: you submitted 217 projects; the 16 most successful of them are starting to be implemented by Brno.

But above all, 11,160 Brnoers participated in the vote in the grand finale, which made it one of the most successful projects in Europe.



In Brno there are 492 photovoltaic, 7 water and 3 wind power stations. All together, the alternative sources produce 41,791 MWh of electricity per year.

SEWER



An invisible network

Only a few can see this network. But still it's there below the surface – a sewer network taking almost the same distance as from Brno to London.

The length of the sewer network has increased with another 3 kilometres.

Brno incinerator is one of the most modern in Europe. Emissions released to the environment are comparable to a heating plant or gas power plant, so it is a very clean source of energy.

HEATS AND SHINES

Almost a million gigajoules of thermal energy and nearly 50 thousand megawatt hours is produced yearly by incinerating the waste.

THE CITY IS CLEANER. YOUTHINK CLEANER. SO TOO.

Over two thirds of Brnoers agree that the city is clean.

In 2013, 53% respondents thought so, in 2009 exactly one half.

This is an increase compared with previous surveys.
